**ORDER**

As per the letters read as first and second paper above, Government of India have sanctioned an amount of Rs. 561.12 lakh and Rs. 106.88 lakh respectively, totalling the amount to Rs.6,68,00,000/- (Rupees Six Crore Sixtyeight lakh only) being Grant-in-Aid to the Kerala State Health & Family Welfare Society under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes for Development of AYUSH under NRHM for 2010-11 towards recurring assistance for upgradation of 30 Ayurveda Hospitals and 20 Homoeopathy hospitals as detailed below and released an amount of Rs. 476.952 lakh and Rs. 90.848 lakh respectively to the State Health & Family Welfare Society, Thiruvananthapuram towards 85% Central assistance. The balance 15% State share ie. Rs. 100.20 lakh has to be met by State Government.
