2. The Dispensaries will be started, subject to the following conditions:-

- The service of Ayurveda Doctors will be provided by the Director of Indian Systems of Medicine, on temporary/contract basis, initially for 6 months, using funds provided by the National Rural Health Mission. The period will be extended further after review of the performance and requirements.

- 2) Dispensaries will start functioning where infrastructure facilities are made available by the Panchayats. Wherever separate buildings are not available, dispensaries will be started, if adequate space for consulting room, stores, toilet etc., is provided in existing/rented building.
- 3) Medicines will be provided for the time being by the concerned District Medical Officers. The Panchayats/Municipalities will also arrange to provide medicines, if possible, from their own funds after getting necessary approvals from the competent authorities.
- 4) The Doctor posted in the dispensary will be responsible for all the duties connected with the treatment of patients, including maintenance of registers, accounts, dispensing medicines as provided etc.
- 5) Service of Pharmacists / Attender / part time sweeper will also be provided by the concerned panchayats at their own expenses.


