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Ever since the incorporation of AYUSH systems into mainstream healthcare as envisaged by

National Rural Health Mission, there has been a growing demand from the public for more infrastructure

facilities & services in this sector. Human Resource Health in this field has subsequently been strengthened.

But there was an acute lack of capacity building & training.

Introduction

Under NRHM, Ayurveda & Homoeo dispensaries were commenced in 2008. In the first phase 41

Homoeo dispensaries and 48 Ayurveda dispensaries were established. In the second phase 101 Homoeo

dispensaries and 52 Ayurveda dispensaries were established. In the third phase 50 Ayurveda dispensaries

were established. There are also 11 Unani Dispensaries, recently established. Altogether there are 303

AYUSH Medical Officer posts in these institutions.

Training objective

Induction Training to AYUSH Medical Officers working in dispensaries established under NRHM.

Training plan

It was proposed to give 2 days state level training to all AYUSH Medical officers. The Medical

Officers under each system of Medicine were divided into batches comprising of 30 doctors each. There

will be altogether **10** batches (Homoeo-4, Ayurveda-5 & Unani-1).
