**ORDER**

The Additional Director of Health Services (FW) in the Note read above has informed that as part of the rolling work plan 2010-11, the UNICEF officials had a discussion with the Chief Secretary, Government of Kerala and agreed to support in setting up of distance education programme for Health Care Providers. It is also reported that in consultation with UNICEF officials, Dr.Thomas Mathew, Nodal Officer, State Disease Control & Monitoring Cell, Thiruvananthapuram was also entrusted to co-ordinate the training programme. UNICEF has approved the budget proposal, for piloting distance education programme for Health Care Providers at CHCs and PHCs of Alappuzha District for an amount of Rs.25,73,500/- (Rupees Twenty five lakhs Seventy three thousand and Five hundred only). Therefore the Additional Director of Health Services (FW) has requested to accord sanction to the Nodal Officer, State Disease Control & Monitoring Cell for conducting the pilot training programme at Medical College Hospital, Alappuzha and for conducting sensitization meeting of Stake holders in this regard at Thiruvananthapuram.
