ORDER

1. As per the Government Order read as 2nd and 4th papers above Government have introduced Special rules for Kerala Health Service (Medical Officers) which, inter alia, consists of Administrative Cadre/Specialty cadre/Super specialty Cadre. Government have also sanctioned additional posts of Junior Specialist, Senior Specialist, Superintendents, Senior Medical consultants and Chief consultant for Specialty Cadre as per the G.O read as 1st and 6th papers above. Subsequently in consultation with Director of Health Services, Government as per the G.O read as 7th paper above approved the institution wise distribution list and Specialty wise seniority list for placement of doctors

2) It was brought to the notice of the Government that the distribution of posts in the Specialty/Administrative Cadre had some anomalies in terms of some districts/ institutions not having adequate

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number of posts. Hence as per the letters read as 9th, 10th & 11th papers above, the Director of Health Services forwarded revised proposals to Government for redistribution and placement of doctors in Administrative and Specialty cadres. As per G.O read as 12th paper above, Government have cancelled the seniority list of doctors approved earlier with a view to revising the seniority list, as it was not in order. As per G.O read as 13th paper above Government had approved the revised institution wise, distribution of posts of Chief Consultant and Senior Consultant. As per G.O read as 14th paper above Government have also issued certain modifications in the norms for calculation of eligible points for fixing seniority in the Specialty Cadre in modification to the G.O read as 12th paper above.

3) As per letters read as 15th paper above Director of Health Services has forwarded the revised lists for the distribution of posts in the Specialty Cadre and Administrative Cadre (including General cadre and Casualty services)

4) Government have examined the proposals of the Director of Health Services in detail and are pleased to order the redistribution of the posts in Administrative Cadre, as detailed in the Annexure -X to this G.O, in the following categories.

The above list includes 59 posts of Superintendent (Civil Surgeon grade) created in G.O read (3) above and additional posts now converted from General cadre. The State Level/District Level and Institutional level distribution of the above posts in Administrative Cadre are given in Annexure II A, B & C to this G.O

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5) Promotions/Placements to the posts in the Administrative cadre will be made from the General cadre based on options. In the case of non-availability of qualified candidates eligible for filling up the posts in the Administrative cadre, the doctors in the General/Entry cadre, with basic qualifications will be considered for appointment in the Administrative cadre, subject to the conditions prescribed by the Government regarding acquiring higher qualifications, training etc.

6) Government are also pleased to order the redistribution of posts in the various grades in the Specialty cadre as detailed in the Annexures 1A to 1P to this G.O in the following categories/grades, under 16 specialties noted.

This list includes 325 posts of Specialists created by G.O cited (3) above, 66 posts created by G.O cited (6) above and additional posts now converted from General cadre from the equated categories(Civil Surgeon/Assistant Surgeons). Specialist posts are now sanctioned in 118 institutions, including 5 Public Health Laboratories, General/District/Taluk level hospitals and a few selected Community Health Centres and Specialty hospitals(including District TB Centres). More Specialist/Consultant posts will be considered later after filling up these posts.

7) In addition to this, Government are also pleased to order the redistribution of Assistant Surgeon/Dental Assistant Surgeon/Casualty Medical Officer posts in the General Cadre in district and Taluk Hospitals to take care of general duties and casualty services. The lists of such posts are given in Annexure-III to this G.O.

8) The above redistribution will be subject to the condition that total posts redistributed will not exceed the total number of sanctioned posts in

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each category. The Director of Health Services will verify and confirm that the total number of posts after redistribution of posts ordered in this G.O does not exceed the total sanctioned strength in respective equated categories. If any variation in the posts are noticed the Director of Health Services will report the same to Government immediately.

9) Abstract of the distribution of all the posts in the Administrative/Specialty/General cadre and Casualty services is given as Annexure IV to this G.O. Director of Health Services will prepare proposals/ lists for placement of eligible doctors in the Specialty Cadre and Administrative Cadre posts sanctioned as above, institution wise, based on the seniority as per norms approved and the options received and submit to the Government for approval.

10) All the Government Orders issued in this regard earlier will stand modified as per this G.O.
