ORDER

As per the letter read above the Director of Medical Education,Thiruvananthapuram submitted a proposal seeking Administrative sanction for the procurement of certain equipments to various Departments in Medical college, Kozhikode, at an estimated cost of Rs.148.5 Lakh meeting the expenditure under the head of account '2210-05-105-97-19 M&E'(Plan) in the current year's budget.

2. The Working Group Meeting for Health & Family Welfare Department held on 13.05.2010 scrutinised the proposal submitted by the Director of Medical Education and approved as detailed in the minutes read above.

In pursuance of the decision of the Working Group, Administrative Sanction is accorded for the procurement of the following medical equipments at a total cost of Rs. 148.5 lakh (Rupees One Crore Forty Eight lakh Fifty Thousand only) for various Departments in Medical College, Kozhikode by meeting the expenditure under the head of account '2210-05-105-97-19 M&E' in the current year's budget subject to the condition that procurement procedures shall be initiated only for the amount of Rs.75Lakh provided in the budget. The Director of Medical Education, will move Government for additional funds in the next SDG, when the funds are exhausted.
