

Equipment Maintenance & Management Programme

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare had initiated a program to establish quality equipment intensive facilities along with suitable mechanisms to ensure proper maintenance of medical devices and equipment to ensure patient safety and good clinical outcomes. It was also informed that high rate of dysfunctional equipment remains at various levels of government hospitals and to address this issue, Government of India have decided to outsource private agencies for comprehensive maintenance of all equipments at PHCs, CHCs, THQH/TH and DH.

In order to achieve the above goals the Director, NHM, Government of India have distributed a draft concept note and model tender document to all states and UTs and 2015 requested to complete the mapping of facility wise inventory of functional/ nonfunctional equipment/ machinery of state.

As desired by Government of India a detailed equipment inventory mapping was done with the in-house facilities utilizing the services of the District Biomedical Engineers (Junior Consultant –Bio Medical Engineering) and uploaded the details in the website of state NHM

Funds for the purpose were included in the PIP 2015-16 under FMR Head B.16 as per Government of India guidelines. As per GOI Guidelines, the calculation of estimate for the purpose is Rs 10-15 per bed/day for equipment maintenance. The estimated amount for eight months comes to Rs.1066 Lakhs.

Government of India had conveyed their approval for Rs.1066.20 Lakhs for the purpose vide Record of Proceedings (ROP) 2015-16 under FMR Head B.16.1.1.3.10.

The Mission Director, NHM, Government of India vide D.O.No.7 (88)/2014-NRHM-1 dated 15.05.2015 has requested to expedite the activities and also informed by Government of India through email that the Hon'ble Prime Minister's Office has been reviewing the Program. Administrative Sanction was accorded to M/s KMSCL for engaging third party maintenance service provider. Tendering process was over. M/s Kirloskar Technologies Pvt. Ltd was selected as the qualified bidder and the process of equipment mapping at institution level is over. Mapped details are submitted for authentication by institution heads

An amount of Rs.1377 Lakhs is provided under Record of Proceedings (ROP) 2016-17 under FMR Head B.16.1.1.3.10.
