## Major activities

- 68 more Urban Health and Wellness Centres(U-HWCs) have been operationised so that a total of 357 such centres are now functional in the state.
- All Urban Primary Health Centres are upgraded into Urban Polyclinics with specialty services on pre notified days of the week. UPHCs in certain districts have gone to the extent of offering services of 9 specialists on designated days of the week.
- All urban PHCs and Urban HWCs are equipped with a reception module as part of the digitisation and the installation of the hospital management system.
- Eight more UPHC in the state got accredited with national quality assurance certification(NQAS)
- All UPHCs and U-HWCs have been integrated into the "Nirnnaya" hub and spoke system for the outsourced diagnostic services to the public at no cost.
- One Urban Public Health Unit established(in Kollam)
- One Urban multi specialty poly dental clinic inaugurated in Kozhikode
- Immunisation sessions started at U-HWCs also(once monthly) as fixed day fixed site session.
