Vide reference cited (1) Government India has given approvals for 13716.20 lakhs under Scheme 6 - Urban Health & Wellness Centres. Vide reference (2) State Government has given detailed guidelines for the implementation of various activities under Scheme 6. Vide reference (3), an amount of Rs 186 lakhs has been allotted as recurring grants for 93 functional Urban Polyclinics, @ 2 lakhs per institution, under Scheme 6 of the XV FC Grant for 2022-23.

Under these circumstances sanction is accorded to allot a limit of Rs 186 lakhs to districts as per the Annexure attached. District Programme Managers are directed to transfer the funds to the concerned Hospital Management Committees of Urban Primary Health Centres with immediate effect. Medical Officer i/c of UPHCs are the implementing officers for the funds, based on proposals submitted and approved by the HMCs. The funds may be utilized for activities as approved in the guidelines read (4) above.

The Medical Officers shall ensure that the following guidelines and regulations are strictly observed in the usage of funds:

1. The fund should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and the expenditure should be limited to the total amount approved.
2. Strict financial control and economy in expenditure should be exercised
3. Expenditure in this regard should be consolidated on a monthly basis at DPMSU and submitted to the undersigned.
